(Carry this in with you to the washing area, so you can use it to dry off a bit before you go back into the changing room)

Large Towel


(Use this to dry off completely in the changing room, before you get dressed again)

You don't have to bring your own! You can also buy or rent these at the bathhouse.



Make the Most of Your Bathhouse Visit!

3 Make sure you don't go into the wrong part of the bathhouse!



2 Pay the admission fee to the person in the lookout seat (sometimes, the lookout seat is inside the changing room), or buy an admission ticket from the vending machine. You can also buy things like soap and shampoo.

1 Take off your shoes and store them by the entrance.



Helpful Info

Nowadays, most bathhouses welcome people with tattoos. Feel free to ask the bathhouse, to make sure.

5 Before you get in the bath, make sure to at least rinse yourself off, to help keep the bathwater clean.

4 Take off all your clothes and put them in a locker — the key goes around your wrist. Don't forget to bring your small towel with you!

6 Put your personal belongings on the shelf while you're not washing off.

7 Enjoy chatting with people from around the area!



Etiquette!

Be careful not to spray the other people around you when you use the showers.

Etiquette!

Don't wash yourself off in the bath. You also shouldn't swim in the bath, or drink alcohol during a bath. To help keep the bathwater clean, make sure your towel stays out of the water. If you have long hair, tie it into a bun to keep it out of the water, too.

Enjoy a drink after your bath, to relax and rehydrate.

9 When you're done bathing, wipe yourself off with your small towel to avoid dripping water in the changing room. Then, in the changing room, use your large towel to dry off completely before you put your clothes back on.

Etiquette!

Don't wash your clothes or dye your hair in the washing area.

8 When washing off, you can use the buckets and the little stools. Feel free to get back in the bath after you wash off!
